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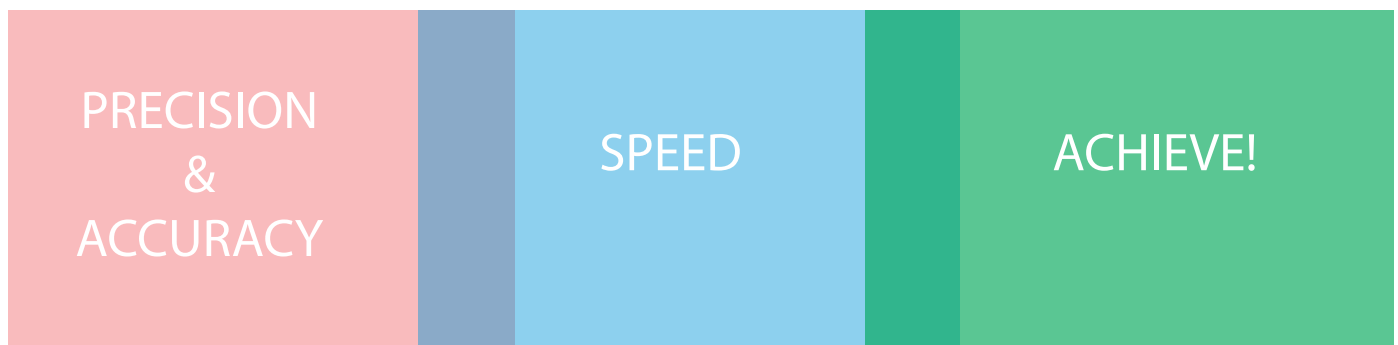
## Our Philosophy: Control the Test!

## Program Details

The Bridge Program is a private lesson program, which includes private lessons, workshop classes, and SAT Practice Tests. Bridge Programs are designed to “bridge” the time gap between the end of a course and the official SAT. Bridges are offered as weekly discounted packages.
